DATE/TIME/LOCATION: February 28, 2018, DHS Music Room, called to order at 6:28 p.m.

2. **MUSIC DIRECTOR'S COMMENTS:**
 - The Music Director introduced herself and reviewed the following upcoming events:
 - Festivals:
 - Thursday, 03/08/18: Band Festival at Carson City Community Center, 7:30 am – 2:30 pm; students are to dress in concert black and will need to bring lunch money
 - Thursday, 03/15/18: Festival Concert, PWLMS, report time 5:45 p.m., concert is at 6:30; dress in concert black
 - Friday, 03/16/18: Wind Ensemble, Reno Band Festival, 7:30 am – 5:00 pm; concert black, need lunch money
 - Friday 03/16/18: Choirific, PWLMS; report 5:30 pm, concert begins at 6:30 pm
 - Music in the Parks, San Jose 05/04/18 – 05/05/18
 - reviewed the packet (including the itinerary, commitment letter, and required deposits)
 - It is critical that all Wind Ensemble members attend—weak attendance numbers will result in the trip being cancelled
 - Cost is \$175 for students; \$30 for chaperones (cost includes hotel, bus, equipment truck, some meals, shirt, park ticket, festival fees, etc.)
 - \$25 deposit is due 03/01/8
 - Students may be signed out following the event by a parent
 - 05/04/18 7:30 am students will drop bags off at the music room for inspection; 10:00 am report for 11:00 am departure (other details of the trip may be found on the itinerary)
 - Students must abide by the Code of Conduct: academic eligibility must be demonstrated to go on the trip; misconduct on the trip may result in parents being required to pick up their student in San Jose
 - Students must meet performance requirements, etc.
 - Students must abide by social media requirements (such as no bullying etc.); otherwise phone will be confiscated for the duration of the trip
3. **PRESIDENT'S COMMENTS:**

The President reviewed the following chaperone needs:

 - Music in the Park: Jazz Band, Concert Band, and Wind Ensemble trip to San Jose May 4-5
 - 10 chaperones are needed on the busses; only 4 have signed up so far
 - Chaperones must be fingerprinted and complete a background check (good for 5 years); they must also have prior experience as a chaperone before they are allowed on an overnight trip
4. **VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT:**

The Vice President reported the following regarding fundraising opportunities for students:

 - Students can use proceeds from sales of raffle tickets to help offset the cost of Music in the Parks or other monies owing. Raffle tickets are \$5 each and raffle prizes include Hard Rock Hotel & CVI staycations.



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- Bowling fundraiser: The bowling tournament is scheduled for March 3rd at Silver Strikes Lanes. Check-in begins at 11:00 am and the tournament begins at noon. Cost per bowler is \$20. There will also be raffles at the tournament.
- The online fundraiser is ongoing and is another source for students to offset their music department related expenses.
